

Kansas City Figure Skating Clubs - Club Ice Contract

KCFSC SKATING SEASON/SCHEDULE: Sept 9, 2024 - April 28, 2025.

CLUB ICE FREESTYLE: Sessions are offered on FRIDAY's at 4:30-5:30 pm and SATURDAY's at 9:40-10:40 am. When sessions are pre-purchased, discounts are applied at \$2 per session for 10 sessions purchased, \$3 per session for 15 sessions purchased, \$4 per session for 20 sessions purchased. "Walk On" rate is \$22. Both Group Lessons and Club Ice Freestyle sessions are offered through EntryEeze to KCFSC members and associate club members. Associate Club Memberships are available at \$45 per year. ***"On-site Punch Cards will be available for purchase at the discount rates above. Unused punch cards are not refundable, unless the ice session is canceled by KCIC or KCFSC."***

KC ELITE ACADEMY GROUP LESSONS: We are excited to introduce "KC Elite" offering group lessons on MONDAY's. The group classes will be led by KCFSC Coaches. Group lessons are offered in 4-week sessions at \$40 per hour and include coach and ice fees. Group lessons are offered on select Monday's beginning September 9th and begin at 4:50-5:50 pm.

KCIC may add additional Friday/Saturday Weekend Outage during the 2023-2024 season. If additional outage is utilized the dates would be announced in advanced and the value of the session(s) impacted would be refunded to the contracted skaters. Any weather-related cancellations will follow KCIC Rink's status. In the event of inclement weather please verify with the rink. If KCIC remains open, club ice sessions will be held, if KCIC decides to close, the facility club ice sessions will be cancelled. Also note that the Clubs reserve the right to preempt any portion of any session upon reasonable notice for special exhibitions. If a session is cancelled the club ice committee will process adjustments either via refunds or a make-up session.

ELIGIBILITY - Skaters who have passed Learn to Skate Pre-Freeskate may utilize all Club Ice sessions. Additionally, skaters who have passed Learn to Skate Basic 6 may only utilize Club Ice on Saturdays. A coach cannot override this level requirement. A skater who is not a member or associate of Kansas City Figure Skating Club may walk on as a guest only one day during the Club Ice season. Guest skaters must be a USFSA member and meet the minimum eligibility requirement as stated above and must sign-in with the ice monitor (Guest Skater Log) and pay the applicable walk-on rate. The only individuals allowed to give instruction to skaters on any club session are KCFSC Home Club and Associate Professional members who are USFSA Compliant. Guest coaches must show proof of USFSA of Compliance and must sign-in with the ice monitor (Guest Coach Log). All skaters, AND PARENTS if the skater is under 18 years of age, must sign a waiver and release of liability form prior to taking the ice.

CONTRACT AND WALK-ON INFO: A maximum of 22 skaters will be allowed on a session. Contracted skaters have first priority. Walk-on skaters will then be allowed on a first-come, first-serve basis. If a session is full, then a skater may take the place of an absent contract skater 5 minutes into the skating session according to the clock by the ice. All skaters need to check in with the ice monitor upon arrival. If a skater does not check-in with the ice monitor, the ice monitor is not responsible for the availability of ice for that skater.

KCFSC Club Ice Waiver, Release of Liability and Contract

This agreement will be governed by the laws of Kansas. Any legal action taken due to disputes arising from this agreement shall be brought in the Johnson County, Kansas District Court.

I hereby release the Kansas City Figure Skating Club along with their officers and members, from any responsibility for injuries suffered during club ice. I agree to abide by the clubs' regulations, ice rules, music procedures, and to pay all ice fees as agreed. All parties, skaters and parents, have read and agree to all rules and conditions detailed in the agreement.

In consideration of participating in activities, I represent that I understand the nature of figure skating activities ("activity") and that I am qualified, in good health and in proper physical condition to participate in such "activity". I acknowledge that if I believe event conditions are unsafe, I will immediately discontinue participation in the "activity".

I fully understand that this "activity" involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the "activity", the conditions in which the "activity" takes place, or the negligence of the "releases" named below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the "activity".

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue Kansas City Figure Skating Club, United States Figure Skating, it's directors, officers, administrators, sponsors, volunteers, agents, employees, staff, instructors, trainers, other participants and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the "activity" takes place (each considered one of the "Releases" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releases" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releases, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the releases from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim. The releases have the right, but not the obligation, to provide rules, regulations and/or ice monitors for Club Ice. We hereby acknowledge that the clubs shall not be responsible for the supervision of the members at Club Ice.

I have read this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AGREEMENT, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

PARENTAL CONSENT AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

I, the minor's parent and/or legal guardian, understand the nature of the above referenced activities and the minor's experience and capabilities and believe the minor to be qualified to participate in such "activity". I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue and AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS, Kansas City Figure Skating Club from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on the minor's account caused or alleged to have been caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releases or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations, and further agree that if, despite this release, I, the minor, or anyone on the minor's behalf makes a claims against any of the above Releases, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS each of the Releases from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss liability, damage, or cost any Releases may incur as the result of any such claim.

Consent for Medical Attention or Treatment: I certify that I, the member, or I, the parent/guardian of said participant, give my consent to the and the facility the activities are taking place in and their staff and to members of the Kansas City Figure Skating Club and their Board of Directors and volunteers to obtain medical care from any licensed physician, hospital or clinic, including transportation and emergency medical services, for myself/ourselves and/or said participant for any injury that could arise from participation in these activities.

Kansas City Figure Skating Clubs - Club Ice Rules for Skaters, Parents and Coaches

All members are expected to follow proper skating etiquette. The rules set forth herein are for the safety of skaters and coaches, so they should be taken seriously. Current Club Ice rules are as follows:

Rules for Skaters/Parents/Coaches - All members are expected to follow proper skating etiquette. The rules set forth herein are for the safety of skaters and coaches, so they should be taken seriously. Current club rules are as follows:

1. All members must be courteous and respectful, both on and off the ice, of property and others. Disrespectful behavior, including but not limited to foul language and/or kicking of the ice or boards, will not be tolerated on club ice sessions. All skaters and professionals must strive to avoid on-ice collisions. Skaters must be careful around those at a higher or lower skating level.
2. The skater whose music is playing has the right-of-way. THIS SKATER MUST BE WEARING A SASH PROVIDED BY THE SKATER. Only the skater whose music is playing and is wearing a sash will be given the right-of-way. Other skaters and coaches must yield to the skater wearing the sash.
3. Skaters in lessons have right-of-way priority immediately below the priority given to the any skater wearing his or her sash.
4. Skaters and coaches should not linger in any of the four Lutz corners and should move out of the area as soon as possible. Spins should be practiced in the middle area of the rink.
5. Skaters who wish to hold extended conversations need to sit on the bench or step off the ice.
6. Observers must watch from the bleachers and are not allowed to stand by the boards.
7. The only individuals that are allowed in the hockey boxes during a club session are contracted skaters, ice monitors, officials, and coaches.
8. Skaters must not wear any electronic devices including phones as they may prevent skaters from being fully aware of others who may have priority. Only coaches may use portable devices for music on the ice.
9. Coaches are limited to four skaters per lesson with the exception of skaters preparing for group numbers for a show. All skaters must still meet minimum eligibility requirements.
10. Props must not endanger any skaters on the ice. They may be used but may not touch the ice.

Illness Prevention Practices - There are a number of new safety measures based on the guidance of health officials including the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and appropriate state, regional, and local government agencies. In addition, KCFSC Club Ice will follow any additional guidelines required by KCIC and USFS. The safety and wellbeing of the skaters, coaches, families, and KCIC partners are our top priorities and guide our decisions. Any guidelines, rules, or restrictions can be modified by KCFSC Club Ice Committee at any time to meet new requirements. Notice of any changes will be provided.

Music Guidelines - Any skater may have his or her music played during a club ice session. Music can be played from a CD or on a cell phone provided the phone is unlocked, the music is cued up, and the skater provides an appropriate phone jack. Skaters should submit their CDs or phone to the announcer's box at the beginning of a session and CDs/phones will be played in the order submitted with the following exception:

- Coaches may "bump" a skater's music to the top of the order ONLY if that skater is in a lesson.
- Coaches may "bump" only once during a given lesson.
- There will be one skater request played between each coach requested "bump".

A piece of music may only be restarted due to technical difficulty. After a skater's music is played, it will be placed at the end of the line where it may be played again after all requested music has been played at least once and the rotation begins again – time permitting. Skaters with two programs will have the second program played with the same priority as if requesting the first program a second time – played as time allows after all other submitted music has been played one time.

Every effort will be made to have a Music Monitor for club ice sessions especially during busy periods prior to competitions and shows. However, in the absence of a session Music Monitor both skaters and coaches must be respectful of each other and support maintaining the above process to the best of their ability.
